<u>Item #6 – Proposed ECO #2.0 Requirements</u>

- IM through C2C
 - Steve Dellenback presented the slides
 - What happens if C2C goes down? Messages previously sent to remote Districts would need to be manually removed by the remote District operational staff.
 - o Could durations for remote signs be sent so that messages would go away if a C2C link is broken.
- Road Ranger

- o John Bonds led discussion
- Central office asked if SwRI collected Road Ranger data was correlated with the requirements
- o Do not address how data is collected in the field
- The D4 SMART software would be the front end that would format the data according to a SunGuide ICD
- o D6 would prefer not to use tablet PCs (they have 36 trucks) want pocket devices that would use wireless connectivity
- D6 would like consideration to use their product as they have spent funds developing – they have a developer available (SIMS – SunGuide Incident Management System)
- o ICD interface provides a generic interface to SunGuide
- o Discussed database management it was described that the Oracle DBA must perform database backups and purging (not a function of the SunGuide software)
- Toll Tag
 - o John Bonds led discussion
 - o SunGuide will talk directly to readers (FDOT controlled devices)
 - o FDOT believes a 10% penetration of vehicles will provide reasonable coverage (MDX indicates that they have 52% coverage)
 - o Data from two sources:
 - Directly from readers
 - From toll agencies
 - o Requirements will be sent out for review and comment
 - o Turnpike will be using MPI 6000
 - o Need to make sure we are Title 21 compliance
 - o SwRI recommended that a specific reader be added to the requirements
- Performance Measures
 - Waiting for input on performance measures from FDOT
